Portfolio: Advocacy

The Advocacy Director coordinates initiatives that enable practice integration and development. This involves helping pharmacy technicians practice to full scope in their current roles and working on strategic initiatives that will expand the pharmacy technician's scope of practice.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Develop tools and communications that clarify pharmacy technician and pharmacy assistant roles.
- Respond to advocacy opportunities within the current environment (HPA changes, compounding, consultations).
- Continue to work on writing a white paper/proposal to have pharmacy technicians granted authorization to inject.
- Stay abreast of changes in the practice environment to identify new advocacy opportunities.

All board members are responsible to:

- Prepare for and attend board meetings and the annual general meeting.
- Report on the status of assigned initiatives and keep the board apprised of completed work.
- Recruit, chair or liaise with committees in order to achieve initiatives.
- Prepare blog submissions to communicate with the membership.
- Approve an annual budget and ensure expenditures are within the budget.
